HISTORICAL BACK GROUND

C.DORMAN RWANDA LTD is one of ECOM East Africa inter-company based in Rwanda and currently known as one stop center for coffee quality solutions in Rwanda.

Ecom/ C. Dorman Rwanda started its operations in Rwanda since 2012 and currently it is operating 7 CWSs named Kanzu,Coproca, Birembo and Cotecaga in nyamasheke District- Western Province, ISHEMA CWS in Rusizi District-Westren Province, MANYANA CWS in Kamonyi District -Southern Province and BUGANZA CWS located in Gatsibo District-Eastern Province.

PROCESSING METHODOLOGY

All CWSs are equipped with MacKinnon disc pulper machine 3 discs. Coffee is hand sorted, floated before being processed. Then coffee is pulped within 8 hours after coffee is harvested. Parchment undergoes dry fermentation for 12-18 hours before the remaining mucilage is washed off, followed by soaking which typically takes 18-20 hours ,before coffee is naturally sun dried . The waste water are isolated with coffee beans and channeled into lined pits and treated with activated effective micro-organism(E.M)

From farm to cup quality of coffee is monitored and lastly Dorman Rwanda Q-Graders cup each and every single lot produced to ensure that the quality of coffee that is going to be shipped meet SPECIALITY requirements
